

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS/EARLY GRADUATION

Twenty-three units of academic credit are required for graduation. The 23 units required for graduation must include the following:

- English (4.0 credits)
- Social Studies (3.0 credits)
- Math (3.0 credits)
- Science (3.0 credits)
- Fine Arts (1.0 credit)
- Physical Education (.5 credit)
- Health must be indicated on transcript, not necessarily for credit
- Personal Finance (.5 credit)
- Computer Science (.5 credit)
- Approved Career & Technical Education, Capstone Experience or Service Learning,
- World Language (1.0 credit of any combination)
- Electives (6.5)

Early Graduation

Students who have earned 18.5 units of credit by the end of their junior year may apply for early graduation. The student shall file a letter of intent with the guidance counselor by the end of his/her junior year. The letter of intent must be signed by the student, parent(s), and administrator.
